

## Klickitat County Sheriff's Office – Jail Visiting Rules

All adult visitors must show valid government issued identification.

All visitors are required to register on the form provided.

Visitors must check in at the lobby no sooner than one half hour before visitation time starts.

A parent or legal guardian must accompany children under the age of 18. Children may not be left unattended at any time. Child visitors are allowed, so long as contact with the inmate is not legally prohibited.

Persons under the age of 18 who are legally married and their spouse is incarcerated, must show documentation of marriage and proper identification to visit.

Persons shown to constitute a threat the security of the facility will be excluded from visiting.

Up to four people may be allowed to visit one inmate at a time.

Visits generally last half an hour; however if an emergency arises in the jail, visiting may be cancelled or shortened without prior notice.

Visitors appearing under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol will not be allowed into visiting.

All visitors will be checked for:

1. Warrants
2. Protection/Restraining Orders/No Contact Orders
3. Any other applicable court orders.

Visitors must abide by the following rules. Visitors who do not follow the rules may be removed from the premises and not allowed future visits.

Proper attire is required at all times. Shoes, shirts, pants and appropriate underclothing is required. The following items are prohibited:

- Halter or tube-type tops
- See-through/sheer fabrics
- Short shorts/cut-offs that are not knee length
- Shirts with low plunging necklines
- Wrap around skirts and crop tops
- Suggestive/revealing clothing including bathing suits

Visitors that come in with personal items will be required to secure them in the locker provided. Visitors will be responsible for the locker key, and must remove items when they exit. It is highly recommended that visitors do not bring any personal items to the visit. The following items are prohibited in the visiting area:

- Cell phones/electronic devices
- Chewing gum
- Food and beverages
- Purses/backpacks/fanny packs/suitcases/duffle bags
- Tobacco/marijuana/lighters/vaping devices
- Drug paraphernalia

Large items like car seats or strollers will need to remain in the lobby or your vehicle. Parents with infant children may bring in one baby bottle, blanket and pacifier. The visiting room and/or jail lobby are not to be used for a baby changing station.

Clothing, hairstyles, insignias or other paraphernalia associated with security threats (i.e. gangs, etc.) or that create undue attention or conflict are strictly prohibited.

Arguing or disrespectful behavior toward staff will not be tolerated.

Disruptive/out of control behavior in children is not allowed. Children must refrain from climbing on the tables/partitions in the visiting room. Children must stay away from the sliding entry door and behave while in the jail lobby.

Violation of any of the above rules may result in termination of the visit and/or suspension of future visitation privileges.
