Notice is hereby given that a Presidential Primary will be held in Klickitat County, Washington, March 10, 2020, in the all precincts within Klickitat County. The election will be conducted by mail ballot.

Voter registration forms are available at post offices, libraries, or at the Auditor's Office. Registrations and updates may also be submitted online at [votewa.gov](http://votewa.gov).

The last day to register to vote, transfer or update an existing registration by mail or online is March 2, 2020. The last day to register to vote or update your voter registration *in person* is March 10, 2020, in the Klickitat County Auditor's Office, 205 S. Columbus Ave. Room 203, Goldendale, WA. The registration books will remain closed until March 20, 2020.

## ***Measures Appearing on the Ballot***

### **President of the United States**

On or before February 21, 2020, the Auditor will mail each qualified voter within the county a mail ballot. Ballots returned by mail must be postmarked by March 10, 2020. No postage is required if mailed within the United States. Ballots returned to our office or dropped into a designated drop box must be returned by 8:00 P.M. on March 10, 2020. Replacement ballots may be obtained in the Auditor's Office or by visiting [votewa.gov](http://votewa.gov).

The Auditor's Office shall provide the availability of registration and voting aids, assistance to elderly and disabled persons, and procedures for voting by mail. Contact the Auditor's Office if you need assistance with a mail ballot.

The Accessible Voting Unit is equipped with audio and visual technology which allows voters with limited vision, hearing, or physical disabilities to vote more independently. This unit is available in the Auditor's Office beginning February 21, 2020, through March 9, 2020, during regular business hours Monday through Friday from 8:30 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. On Election Day, March 10, 2020, the Accessible Voting Unit is available from 8:30 A.M. to 8:00 P.M. If you are a person with a disability who needs any accommodation in order to participate in this program, you may be entitled to receive certain assistance. Please contact the Auditor's Office at (509) 773-4001, (800) 583-8050 or by emailing [voting@klickitatcounty.org](mailto:voting@klickitatcounty.org), no later than five working days prior to the date service is needed.

The Logic and Accuracy Test of the programming to be used for ballot tabulation will be held February 26, 2020. The public is invited to observe this test at 10:00 A.M. in the Auditor's Office.

The canvassing board, pursuant to RCW 29A.60, will hold a public meeting at 8:30 A.M., March 17, 2020, to examine returns and at 8:30 A.M., March 21, 2020, in the Auditor's Office to certify the cumulative results, precinct results and a reconciliation report of the votes cast.
